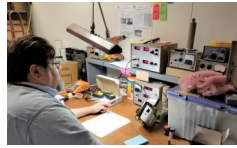


The Health Physics Society provides education and tools to professionals involved in ionizing and nonionizing radiation.

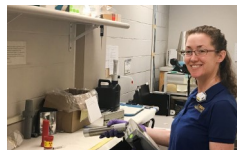
The Health Physics Society offers educational resources covering ionizing radiation, nonionizing radiation, radiation detection, and radiation research.

Our goal is to provide information that aids the public in understanding radiation and health physics.



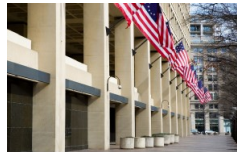
